## First Exam

Consider the system of equations

$$\begin{aligned}
 x_1 + x_2 + x_3 + x_4 &= 3 \\
 x_1 - x_2 + x_3 - x_4 &= 3 \\
 2x_1 + 2x_3 &= 6
 \end{aligned} \tag{1}$$

- 1. Write down the augmented matrix for the system of equations (1).
- 2. Put this matrix into reduced row-echelon form.
- 3. What is the rank of this matrix?
- 4. Write down the solution of the system in terms of spanning vectors and a translation vector (that is, in parametric form).
- 5. Does the solution represent a point, line, plane, or some higher-dimensional object?
- 6. Write down a matrix A and a vector b such that Ax = b corresponds to the system (1), where  $x = [x_1, x_2, x_3, x_4]^T$ .
