

Corrections to the paper:

**Guaranteed Intervals for Kolmogorov's Theorem (and
Their Possible Relation to Neural Networks)**

In Section 1 titled *A Little Bit of History ...*, the word “continuous” should be added in two places:

- the paragraph titled *1900: Hilbert's 13th problem*, instead of “but no matter what functions ...” should be “but no matter what continuous functions ...”.
- In the paragraph titled *1957: Kolmogorov's solution*, instead of “and some functions of one variable” should be “and some continuous functions of one variable”.

In both cases, the addition is necessary to avoid the famous example of a Peano curve that go through all points of the plane. These typos do not affect the mathematical part of the paper. We are thankful to Dr. David Sprecher who noticed them.
