REQUIREMENTS FOR MANUSCRIPT PREPARATION

A manuscript should be printed on a standard typewriter with a black ribbon. The interval should be 4 lines per inch. Text should be typed on one side of white paper 210x297 mm (A4) without numbering pages. The space for text is 160×242 mm (approx. 63 chars × 38 lines), margins are 30 mm - left; 20 mm - right and top, 35 mm - bottom. Illustrations should be placed directly in the text (in black color).

One can use a printer to prepare manuscripts while text characteristics should be similar to typewriter's (10 characters per inch. 4 lines per inch). As far as it is possible the font should be similar to a typewriter's. The vertical size of letters should be bigger than 2 mm. At least Near-Letter-Quality or 24-pin printer is required.

The title of a paper is printed in capital letters at the top of the first page in the center of the line. Name(s) of author(s) and abstract (up to 8 lines with 5 characters indention from left and right) are placed below. After that title, name and abstract in Russian (in English if the text is in Russian) are placed. If you can not write in Russian, please, leave a blank space for this purpose. This header is separated from the text by a blank line. References are placed in the end of text like in this one. Add an extra space between title and name, name and abstract etc. After the text place a blank line and type on the right side of the paper your address for correspondence.

Authors should send three copies of a manuscript, at least one of them should be prepared with a special care. Please send papers in big envelopes with hard linings to prevent paper jam.
